-those not in the first 8 duets hold the A major chord "where" for 8 beats, getting softer

-solo quartet enter amid the canon in 4-part, half time

-canon duets slowly join the solo quartet, when they choose to, so that all singers end the verse together in parts at half time

Tag: all sing the last phrase "there must be a God somewhere" in parts at half time
